An express repairer's lien is acknowledged on the above vessel to secure the amount of repairs thereto. Northshore Yachtworks will not be held responsible for loss or damage to the vessel or articles left in the vessel in case of act of God or any cause beyond our control.

When the invoice exceeds \$5,000.00 CDN Northshore Yachtworks will notify the owner and run that amount on the credit card number provided. Work will not proceed until payment has been received on the past balance.

Parts and labour carried out on behalf of an Insurance company or warranty work on behalf of a Yacht builder will be invoiced directly to the vessel owner for payment. The vessel owner is responsible to contact their insurance provider or vessel manufacturer for reimbursement (unless other arrangements have been made prior to commencement of work).

PAYMENT TERMS

- All accounts are due and payable on receipt.
- Vessel will not be released until payment in full has been received.
- Progress payments will be billed weekly or bi-weekly.
- All charges will be billed to Credit Card info provided unless otherwise arranged.
- All unpaid invoices will be subject to a 2% per month interest fee.
- Signing this service agreement constitutes written authorization to charge invoice amounts on the credit card provided.
- A deposit for the cost of parts will be taken at commencement of work on large projects and new installations.
- Proof of primary insurance is required.
- Moorage will be charged unless included in the quote for the project. (If applicable)
- Canadian Customs clearance numbers and boat official numbers are required for tax deferment at the start of the project. (No cruising while the vessel is on a work permit and direct exit from Canada upon completion of work is required)
- A US Customs entry number is required on export of boat to have sales tax credited on Credit Card.
- Vessels departing Canada before invoices are paid will have charges run on the credit card provided.
